Who is FwFL?

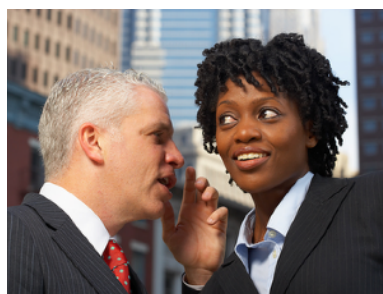
